

Instructions for Donor-Advised (DA) Contributions

MAKING A DA GIFT THROUGH NIF IN THE UNITED STATES (MINIMUM DONATION: \$100)

1. **Checks** (of \$100 or more) should be made payable to “New Israel Fund”. Please write donor-advised to [grantee name] in the check memo, accompanying letter, or both. (e.g. “Donor-advised to X grantee / DA to X grantee.”)

Due to Covid-19, NIF offices are currently processing donations received by mail 1-2 times a week. To expedite processing, donations should be sent to: New Israel Fund, PO Box 70358, Philadelphia, PA 19176-0358 (Please note new POB address as of June, 2021)

Donations can also be sent to NIF’s national office in New York. Please contact Sarah Temmer at DAGifts@nif.org for the mailing address. Please do not send donations to NIF’s DC office.

2. Instructions on making a **wire transfer** [can be found here](#). *To ensure that the donor and DA grantee are correctly identified, please make sure to follow the instructions regarding notifying NIF of donations.*
3. **Online donations:** A limited number of grantees have dedicated online donation pages on the NIF DA portal; click [here](#) and search by key word or issue area. Due to the expense entailed, NIF does not currently offer the option of DA donations by credit card, aside from to these grantees through the portal.

MAKING A DA GIFT THROUGH NIF UK

1. To make an **online gift**, visit <https://newisraelfund.org.uk/donation/>. Please add the grantee name in the Comments (Gift Detail) box.
2. **Checks** should be made payable to the New Israel Fund mailed to: New Israel Fund, Star House, 104-108 Grafton Rd, Kentish Town, London NW5 4BA. The letter must include the name of the donor and a cover note stating that the donation is donor-advised gift to X organization. If the donor wishes to receive a receipt for their donation, they should also add their postal and/or email address to the cover note.
3. **Bank transfer** [\[View PDF\]](#). The donor needs to send an email to info@uknif.org which includes the full name of donor, the name of the grantee and their email and/or postal address if they wish us to send them a receipt.

IMPORTANT: To ensure that the donor is correctly identified and the gift correctly attributed to your organization, please make sure that your donors send NIF UK all details stated above

Please note that currently donations are transferred once every 3 months, and entail a fee to cover expenses.

A note on processing and transfer times for gifts via NIF US

If status and documentation are in order, funds are transferred to the grantee around the 20-25th of the month following the month in which NIF received the gift (e.g. a gift received between January 1-31 will be transferred around February 20-25th).

Please note that **the grantee organization** is responsible for ensuring that all documentation is current and complete and submitted to NIF's Jerusalem office. If documentation is not up to date, the transfer of grants to the grantee will be delayed until it is completed. This will not affect the deposit, recording and recognition of the gift for tax and other purposes.
